

- may be used for community college with the intent of receiving a bachelor's degree



NORWAY SOVEREIGN WEALTH FUND – RECENT NEWS

Norway's sovereign wealth fund, the **world's largest**, gained \$53 billion last year after stocks rallied following the election of Donald Trump and as the fund increased its investment in emerging and frontier markets.

The **\$900 billion** "Government Pension Fund Global" returned 6.9 percent in 2016, after rising 2.7 percent the previous year, the Oslo-based investor recently reported. (For comparison, note that the California Public Employees Retirement Fund reported well less than a one percent – 0.06% - return for its fiscal year that ended June 30, 2016.)

The fund had investments in 77 countries at the end of 2016 after Argentina was added during the year, it said.

Camp Norge Flooded out



“Fueled by an atmospheric river that funneled a vast amount of moisture into Northern California, the severe winter storms that hit last month caused countywide damage. Perhaps the most prominent is the culvert failure and washout of Morton Road in Alta. The incident isolated 15 homes (and Camp Norge). An alternative access was established, however it traverses a steep, windy gravel road over private property,” according to the Placer County newspaper. The picture to the left is where the road used to be, and you can see the depth of the washout. This was a major event!

In mid-February, the county expects to put out the bid to build a permanent bridge over the washout, and “hopes” to complete construction by the end of June 2017. They have \$3 million to complete the project. So----can we expect access to Camp Norge by the end of June? We don’t really know and we won’t know until the project is complete, to be completely honest and realistic.

As of now, we are cancelling all activities scheduled through the end of July, including Camp Trollfjell and Trollfjell Folkehøgskule. With this natural disaster occurring, there will be no revenue for Camp Norge during these months. Therefore, our Caretaker has graciously agreed to resign from his position and leave the Camp. Camp Norge will remain closed to any visitors, whether Sons of Norway members or not, until this road repair is completed.



The Recreation Center Board of Directors has met over this issue, and the Camps Trollfjell’s Administrative Committee has had conversations. The Camp is financially prepared to be closed at this time. However, there are always ongoing expenses that must be met. Any Lodges or Sons of Norway members who wish to contribute to Camp Norge expenses are encouraged to do so. We will also be applying for a “Helping Hands to Members” Grant through the Sons of Norway Foundation to aid in this disaster.



Thank you all for your patience and understanding. We are looking forward to the opportunity to turn this “lemon into lemonade” and reopen later this year with great programs and activities, especially Hardanger Camp in August, Northern California Kretsstevne over Labor Day weekend and Rosemaling in October!! We’ll keep you posted!

Scholarships are awarded to an Undergraduate Student attending any accredited post-secondary schooling or training institution.

Applicant for this scholarship must be a current Unge Venner* or a Youth Member of a Sons of Norway, District Six Lodge

Application must be postmarked on or before April 1, 2017

For the school year 2017-2018, District Six is pleased to award **three (3) scholarships of \$1,000 each**, to students entering their sophomore, junior or senior year in an accredited post-secondary schooling or training institution in the USA. Scholarships awarded will be payable jointly to the student and the institution of learning and mailed to the student before August 1 of the application year. Students may apply each year of their undergraduate study.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. * A youth between the ages of 16 and 23 inclusive, who is a lineal descendent or resides in the same household as a District Six Sons of Norway member in good standing; or a youth member paying Unge Venner dues.
2. Applicant must be 23 years old or younger on April 1 of the application year.
3. Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited post-secondary schooling or training institution.
4. Applicant must be a full-time undergraduate student who has completed at least one (1) term (semester or quarter) of studies. Scholarship funds are intended to be awarded for studies in the sophomore, junior or senior year.
5. Applicant's college or university Grade Point Average (GPA) must be 2.50 or higher, based on a letter grade scale of A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0.

PLEASE COMPLETE THE ATTACHED APPLICATION FORM AND RETURN WITH THE FOLLOWING:

Check list of Requirements:

Include ALL items required in 1 envelope. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. Application form completed and signed.
2. Official transcript in a sealed envelope from the accredited institution you are attending, presenting work you have completed to date.
3. Two letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes: 1 from a faculty member of the institution you are attending and the other from a member of your lodge in District Six.
4. A statement of extra-curricular activities in which you participate, verified by documentation.
5. Sons of Norway activities and events in which you have taken part.
6. Essay of not more than 250 words, describing your current understanding of your career goals, how you plan to pursue them and how your studies will honor the Scholarship and the Sons of Norway.
7. Recent photo (headshot) no smaller than 3 inches wide by 4 inches high.
